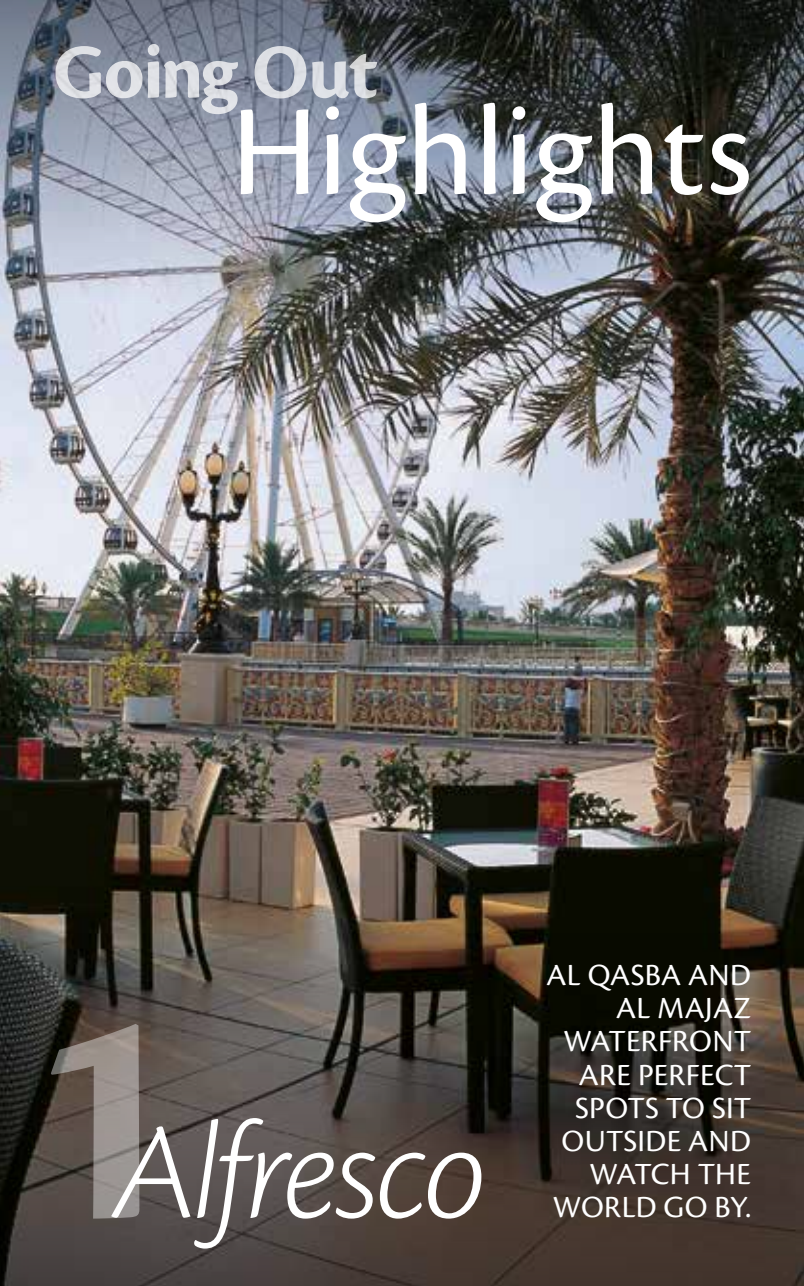
FOOD STALLS...
